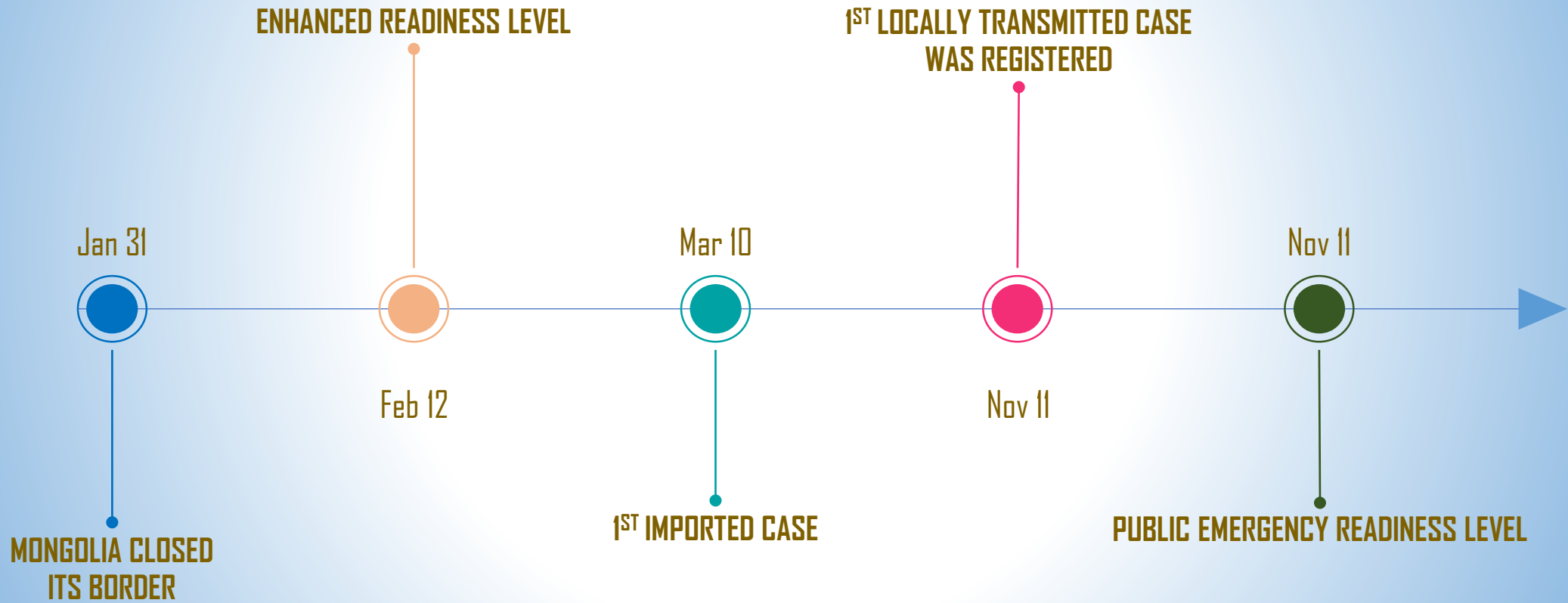

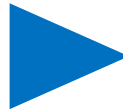


## POLICY AND DECISIONS RELATED TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

### PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST COVID-19

- Rule of law in the time of Covid-19 was adopted
- Public activities, entertainments were banned
- All levels of educational institutions moved to digital form
- “Interaction and Response to the Covid-19 pandemic” trainings and practices were organized
- Arrangements were made to repatriate and quarantine the citizens from abroad

### RESPONSIVE MEASURES IN CONNECTION OF CONFIRMATION OF LOCAL CASE

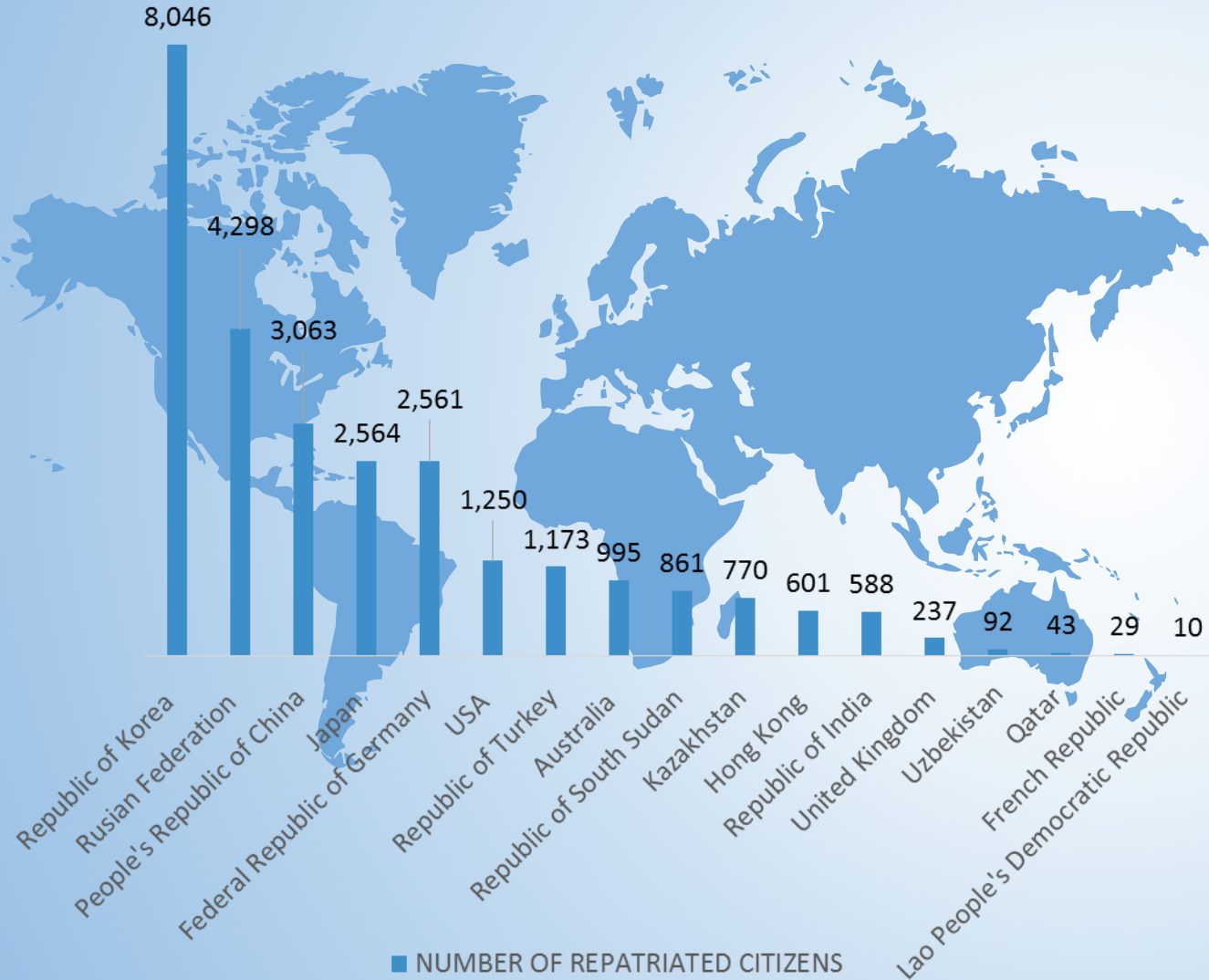
*/Strict lockdown/*

- Domestic travel was restricted
- Intercity road traffic movement was reduced by 70-90 percent
- All levels of educational institutions moved to digital form
- Some private and public organizations activities were restricted
- Relevant measures and surveillance studies are taken to each confirmed cases
- Implementation of procedures for returning people who are detained in UB due to the lockdown
- Voluntary testing centers were established
- “One Household- One Person” project commenced.

# REPATRIATION



**27,184 CITIZENS WERE RETURNED BACK HOME FROM 91 COUNTRIES**

- By charter flights – **20,582**
- By land ports of entry - **6,602**



## SUPPORTING PEOPLE'S LIVELIHOOD DURING THE PANDEMIC



- Exemption from personal income tax and social security tax
- Monetary allowances are provided for each child
- Mortgage repayment has been postponed
- Refined coal prices have been reduced by 50 percent
- Food packages were provided to low-income people
- Homeless people were provided with temporary shelter services



## CHALLENGES



- Economic difficulties and unemployment
- Scarce resource of medicines and medical equipment
- Social issues
