NEAR (1996)	Metropolitan and local self-governing governments in China, Mongolia, ROK, DPRK, Japan and the Russian Federation	Trade and economic cooperation, youth and cultural exchange	C2C exchange, international forum
GTI Local Cooperation Committee (2011)	China, Mongolia, ROK and the Russian Federation	Transport, trade, investment, tourism, energy, environment and agriculture	Policy coordination between local and central authorities, joint projects, info exchange and knowledge sharing; Local Development Forum
ICLEI East Asia (2012)	Greater China region, Japan, ROK, and Mongolia	Low carbon, resilient and environmentally friendly cities, green and circular economies	Technical consulting, training and info services, capacity building, local and regional programs, international cooperation (global network)

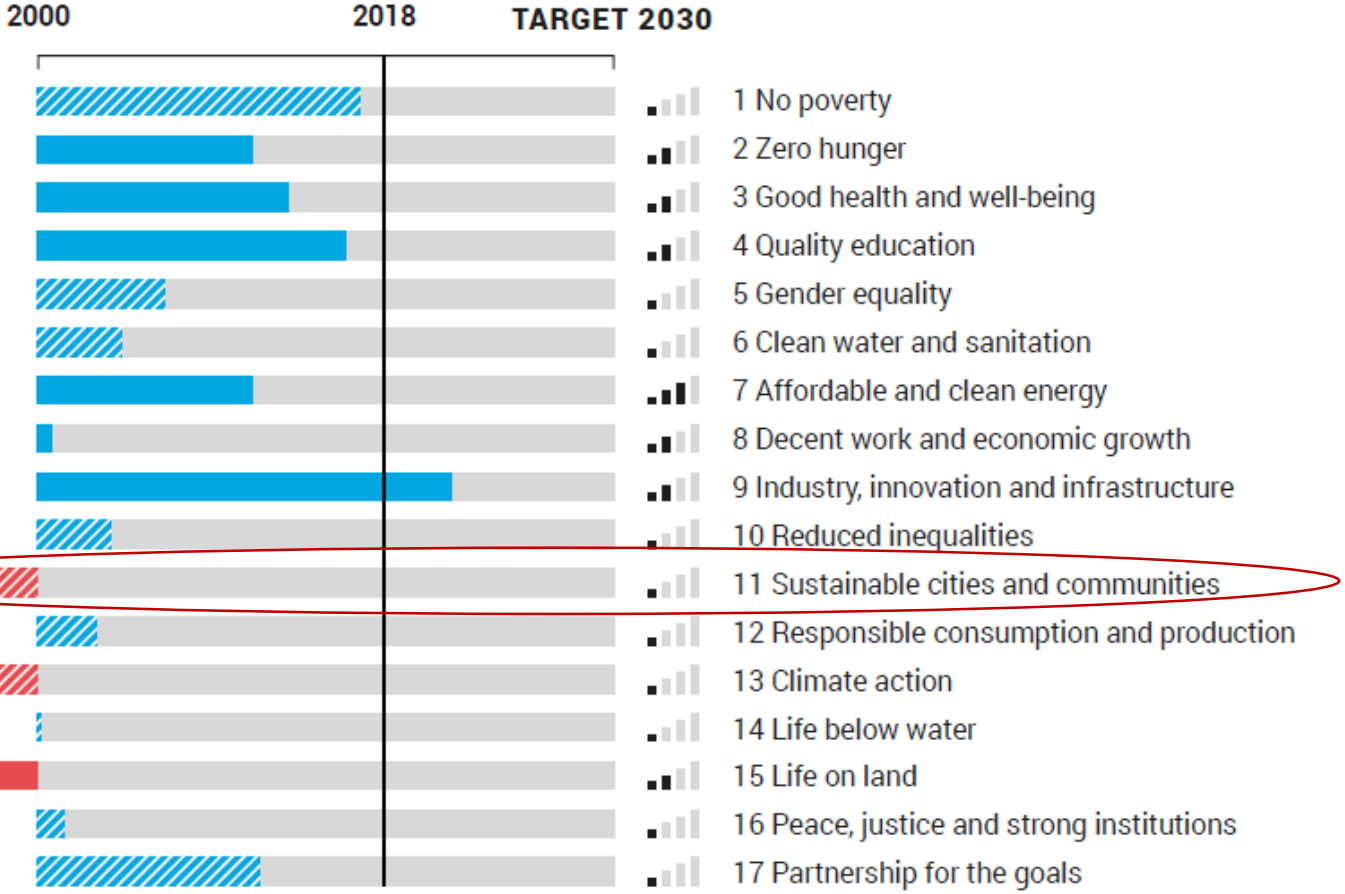

Anticipated progress in 2030: East and North-East Asia

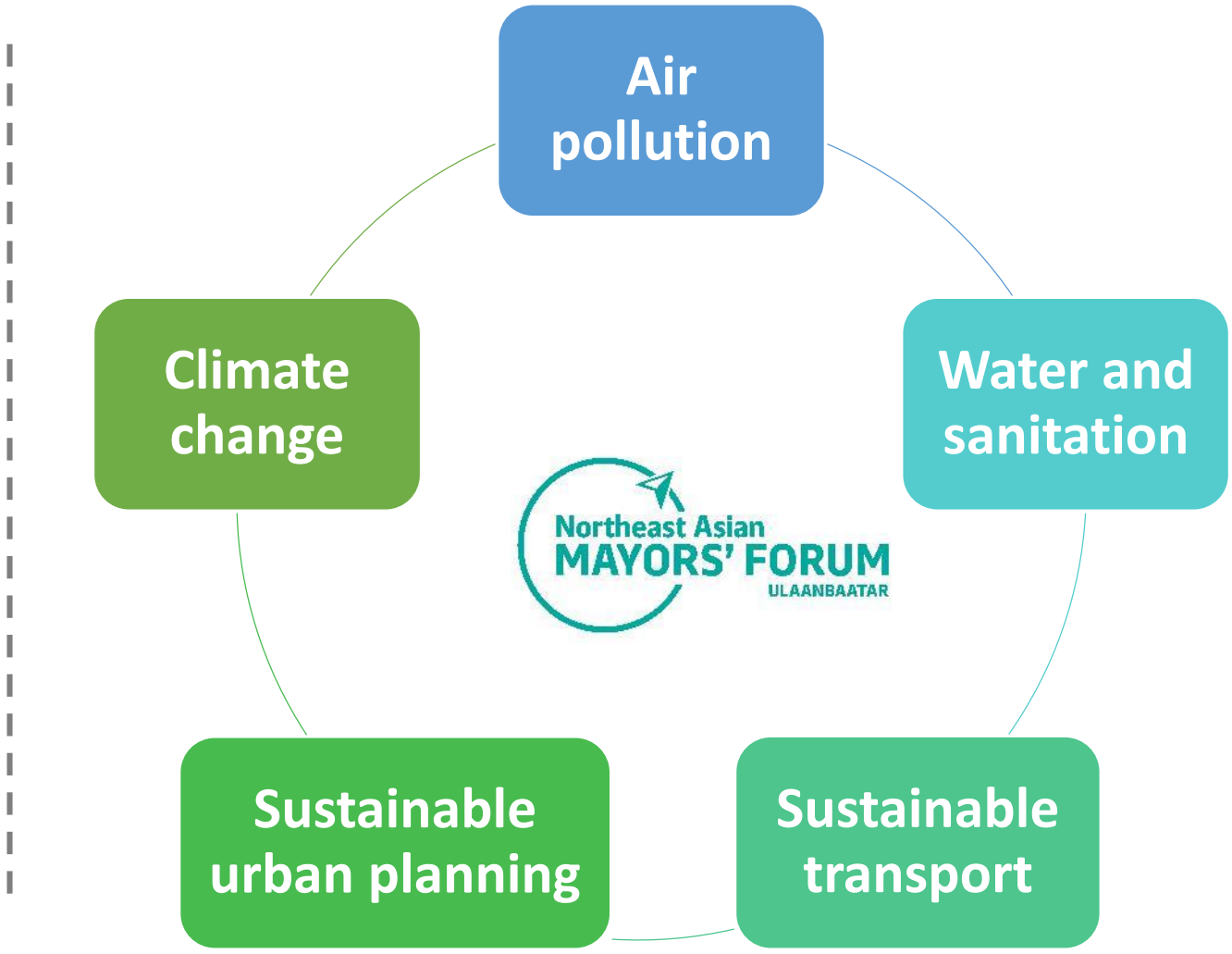

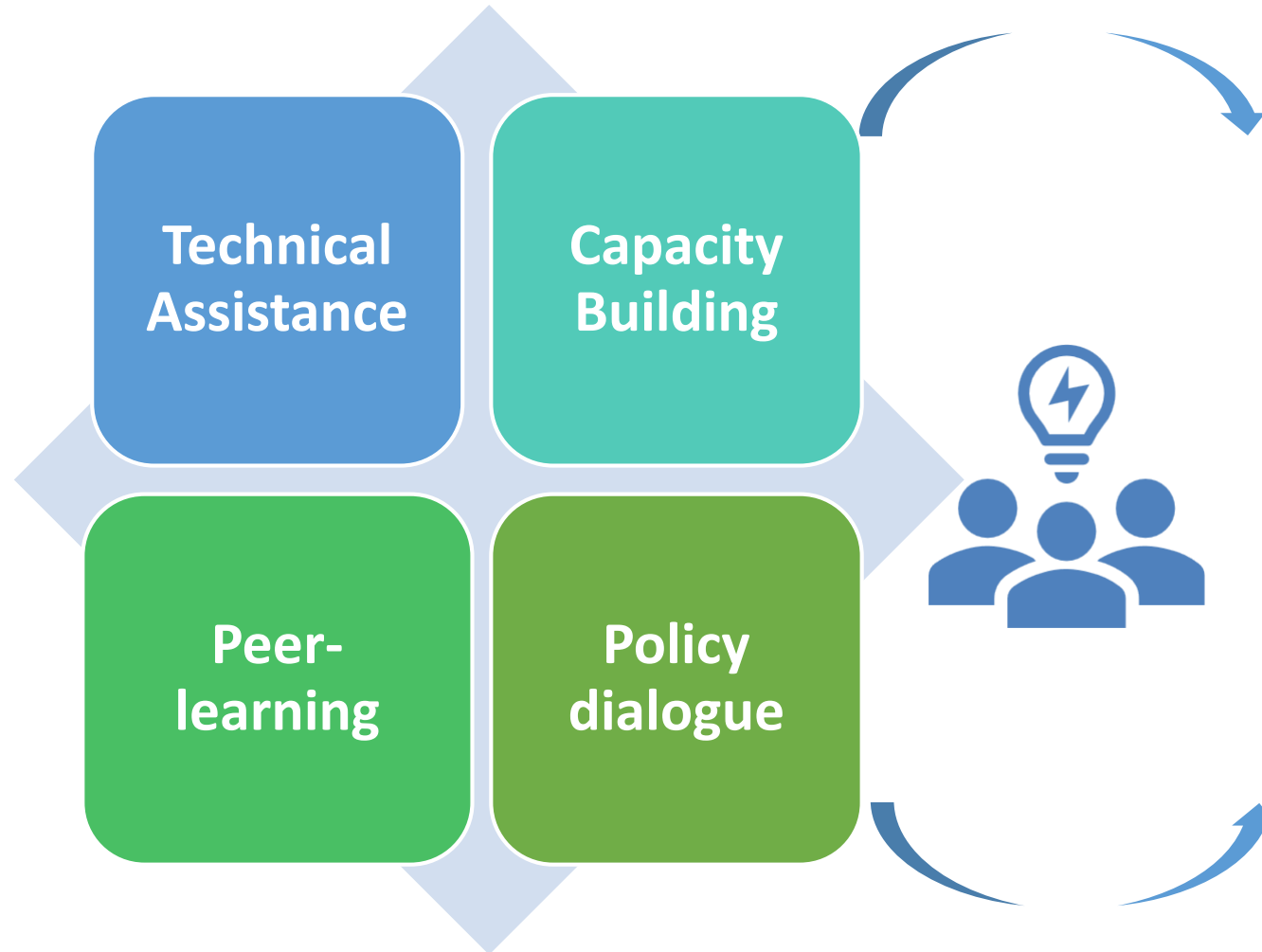
